Fill your maintenance medications in a 90-day supply

Your plan includes a maintenance medication program called Cigna 90 NowSM. “Maintenance medications” are the medications you take every day to treat an ongoing health condition like diabetes, high blood pressure, high cholesterol or asthma. **With Cigna 90 Now, your plan only covers maintenance medications when they’re filled:**

- 1. In a 90-day (or three month) supply.**¹ Depending on your plan, you may be able to receive coverage for one, two or three fills in a lesser amount before switching. However, once you run out of these fills, your plan will only cover the medication if you fill it in a 90-day supply.
- 2. At a 90-day pharmacy in your network.** Once you get a 90-day prescription from your doctor, make sure you use a 90-day retail pharmacy in your network, or Cigna Home Delivery PharmacySM.² If you don’t use a pharmacy that’s approved to fill 90-day supplies, your plan won’t cover the cost of your prescription.

This document shows the maintenance medications your plan requires you to fill in a 90-day supply to receive coverage. Medications are listed alphabetically by the condition they treat. Brand name medications are capitalized and generic medications are lowercase.

The Cigna 90 Now Maintenance Drug List is regularly updated so it’s important to know that this is not a complete list of covered medications, and not all of the medications listed here may be covered by your specific plan.

You should log into the **myCigna**[®] website or app or check your plan materials to learn more about how your plan covers maintenance medications. You can also use the Drug Cost tool to estimate how much your medication may cost and view lower cost alternatives, if available.³ You can also go to **Cigna.com/Rx90network** to find a 90-day retail pharmacy in your network.

Cigna does not take responsibility for any medication decisions made by the doctor or pharmacist. Cigna may receive payments from manufacturers of certain preferred brand medications, and in limited instances, certain non-preferred brand medications, that may or may not be shared with your plan depending on its arrangement with Cigna. Depending upon plan design, market conditions, the extent to which manufacturer payments are shared with your plan and other factors as of the date of service, the preferred brand medication may or may not represent the lowest-cost brand medication within its class for you and/or your plan.



1. You may be taking a medication that isn't actually available in a 90-day supply. Certain medications may only be packaged in lesser amounts. For example, three packages of oral contraceptives equal an 84-day supply. Even though it's not a "90-day supply," it's still considered a 90-day prescription.
2. Not all plans are the same, so some plans may not include Cigna Home Delivery Pharmacy. Please log in to the myCigna website or app, or check your plan materials, to learn more about the pharmacies in your plan's network.
3. Prices are not guaranteed, and even though a price is displayed in the Drug Cost tool, it's not a guarantee of coverage. Your costs and coverage may change by the time you fill your prescription at the pharmacy, and medication costs at individual pharmacies can vary. For example, your pharmacy's retail cash price for a specific medication may be less than the price shown in the Drug Cost tool. Coverage and pricing may change.
